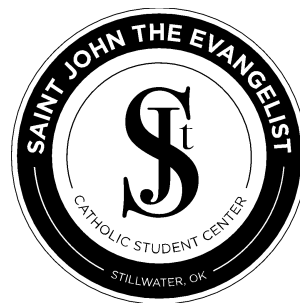

Saint John Catholic Student Center Campus Ministry Internship Description

What is a Campus Ministry Intern and what do they do?

The Campus Ministry Interns are at the heart of the apostolic work of Saint John Catholic Student Center. They are engaged in all of the works of the campus ministry; their particular responsibility is the cultivation of the St. John CSC community. The interns have direct access to the Pastor and the Director of Campus Ministry in order to assist them in evangelization of the students of Oklahoma State University. The interns will work together to foster fellowship and charity among the student community under the guidance of the Director of Campus Ministry. Interns may also assist in areas of Liturgy, Service to the Poor, OCIA, Event Planning, Retreats, and other things based on experience and where help is needed at the time, and inasmuch as that assistance complements their primary responsibility, which is the cultivation of community. In addition, interns will meet as a team with the Director of Campus Ministry for planning and spiritual formation and will be asked to perform a wide variety of tasks. The interns will work to make Saint John a welcoming and friendly place for students to make their spiritual home.

What are the primary expectations of an intern?

Campus Ministry Interns are part of the core leadership at St. John Catholic Student Center. As such, they are expected to lead by example in the Christian life.

- Interns are expected to be living a life of prayer—i.e. daily Holy Hour, daily Mass, praying the Rosary, Liturgy of the Hours, etc.
- Interns live in community— in addition to planning and running the community events, the Interns will be expected to attend and participate in the community at St. John
- Interns are expected to be available whenever school is in session, including holidays when classes are in session i.e. Holy Week, Easter, and maybe more.
- Interns are expected to speak and act in prudence, temperance, and charity—in other words, to strive to be saints, and to help others to do so.

How long does the internship last?

The internship is a one-academic-year commitment with an option to reapply for a second year. Interns will be asked to report for training **August 10th** (date subject to change). The last day of employment will be early May (typically Graduation Day).

What are the benefits of a pastoral intern?

- A monthly stipend
- Weekly spiritual and intellectual formation (*Certificate of Catechesis* will be provided if completed satisfactorily)
- Ability to make important ministry decisions on behalf of the student community

- Learn the core aspects of ministry while in a college setting
- Non Profit work experience for future career endeavors
